Executive Chef James Hackney has helmed the culinary team at Wequassett for the past decade. He is credited with elevating the status of twenty-eight Atlantic to its coveted Forbes Five-Star status. Prior to Wequassett, Chef Hackney served as Chef de Cuisine at Boston's legendary L'Espalier and other notable restaurants.

Chef Frank McClelland is a New England-based culinary icon known for developing the Northeast's next generation of cooking talent and for owning L'Espalier, an acclaimed restaurant in Back Bay.

A teenage stint as a dishwasher in native West Newbury, Massachusetts led to a lifelong love of culinary arts for Jared Bacheller. Upon graduation from the Culinary Institute of America, Jared worked at The Ritz-Carlton, Boston, followed by seven years at renowned L'Espalier restaurant. While at L'Espalier, Jared staged in Copenhagen at cutting edge Noma, and in New York at Per Se, Eleven Madison Park, and Le Bernardin.

Chef Ashley Abodeely, Former Sous Chef at L'Espalier, will also make a guest appearance! Post L'Espalier, Ashley continued her impressive career at Eleven Madison Park, The NoMad Hotel New York, and most recently, The NoMad Los Angeles.

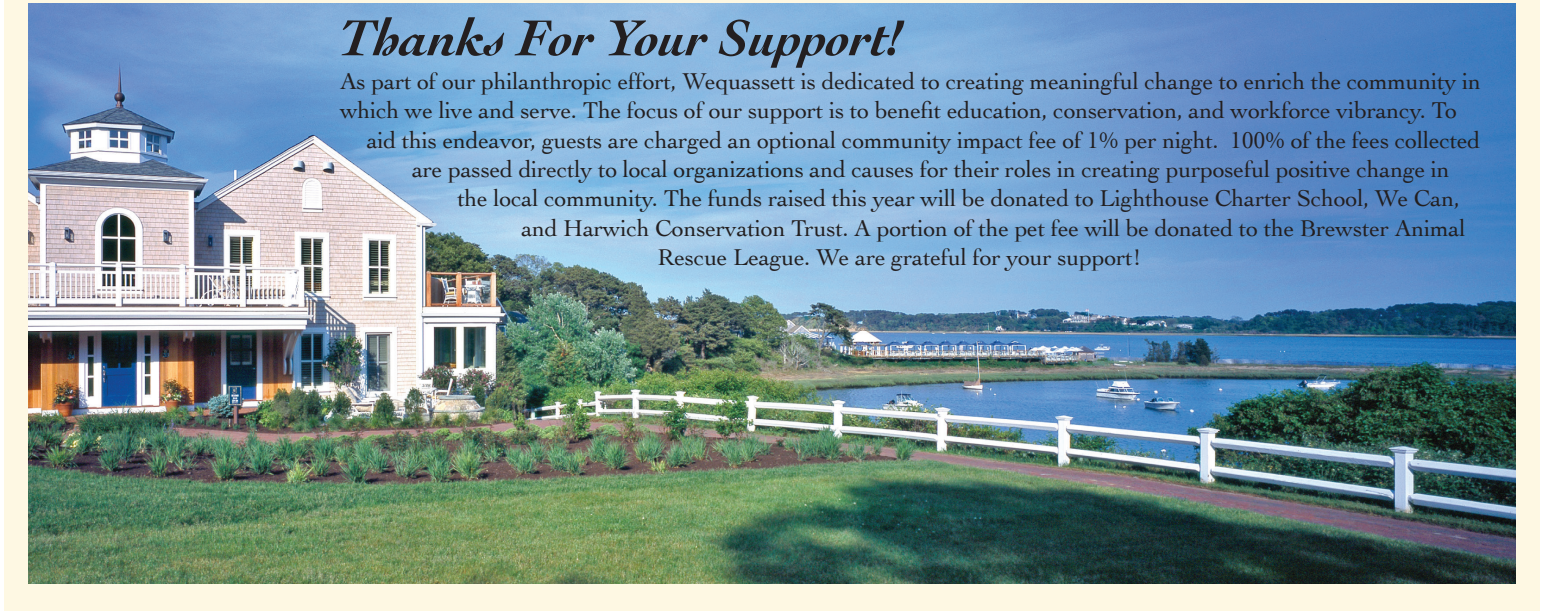

NOVEMBER ACTIVITIES

Walks, Birding, Golf, Museums, Lighthouse Tours and Day Spa



Seashore Strolls

There are six pristine sandy beaches at the Cape Cod National Seashore. Local favorites include the broad sandy **Nauset Light Beach in Orleans**, the breathtaking **Coast Guard Beach in Eastham**, and the historic **Marconi Beach in Wellfleet**. For a unique experience, visit the **Brewster Flats**, comprised 12,000 acres of tidal flats extending nine miles from Brewster to North Eastham, the largest flats in North America.

Walks and Birding

For a peaceful walk and exciting birding you'll love these Cape paths.

Taylor Bray Farm in Yarmouthport dates to the Plymouth Colony. This historic farm is home to a boardwalk that passes through Black Flats Marsh. Explore the farm and take a stroll along the boardwalk, where you can enjoy the fall color and dunes of Chapin beach and Cape Cod Bay.

Nickerson State Park, Brewster with its beautiful woodlands, freshwater kettle ponds and many trails offers varied scenic walking for nature enthusiasts. If you prefer biking, the park's eight miles of paths take you in and out of scenic forests.

Beech Forest Trail, Provincetown on Race Point Road is a one-mile walk that is home to a hidden forest. The trail surrounds a freshwater wetland, as it passes ponds and winds through smaller dunes.

The tidal flats of **Chatham's South Beach and Monomoy National Wildlife Refuge** are a must-see for avid birdwatchers. As described by ornithologist, Vern Laux as "far-and-away the best place to see remarkable numbers and variety of birds."

Golf

November is an ideal time to discover Cape Cod's "Golf Coast" with over 40 courses that run the gamut of all skill levels, and will challenge amateur to pro. Begin with a round on our course, Cape Cod National Golf Club, rated one of the Best Golf Courses in Massachusetts by Golf Digest. The championship, par-72 course is available exclusively to members and guest of Wequassett. Our concierge will recommend additional courses and reserve your tee times.



Saturday Chatham Lighthouse Tours

Travel to the Chatham Lighthouse with Caption John to see the iconic 40 ft beacon and to hear the over 200-year history of the many Chatham Lighthouses that guided mariners safely around the elbow of the Cape. Hear the story of the famous rescue by the young Chatham Coast Guardsmen in 1952 on the CG 36500. Known as the most heroic small vessel rescue in Coast Guard history, the boat has been beautifully restored and can be visited at its present winter location in Orleans if time permits. This 90-minute tour is offered Saturdays at 9:30am. Advanced reservations required, \$50 per adult.

Museums

Atwood Museum in Chatham is home to the Chatham Historical Society and includes over 4,000 paintings, decorative arts, maritime artifacts, etc. Explore the Museum grounds and outbuildings, including an 18th century herb garden and The Nickerson North Beach Camp. [chathamhistoricalsociety.org]

Cape Cod Museum of Art, Dennis
The CCMoA preserves the work of the Cape's finest artists and celebrates the distinctive artistic identity of the Cape, the Islands and the region. The Museum is surrounded by a sculpture garden at the Cape Cod Center for the Arts. [ccmoa.org]

The Heritage Museum and Gardens in Sandwich has 100 acres of grand grounds and trails and a collection of over 18,000 items celebrating the culture of the people in southeastern New England. The gardens in fall abound the with dahlias, asters, sedum and Japanese anemone. [heritagemuseumsandgardens.org]

The Cape Cod Museum of Natural History in Brewster offers collections-based exhibits, including whales, birds, live marine science exhibits and environmental educational programs for adults and children. The grounds have three nature trails and a wildflower garden. [ccmnh.org]
