

Low Tide Clamming with Captain John Geurtsen

Free from summer crowds these trails offer tranquil cycling for all levels.

Cape Cod Canal Bikeway: Ideal for casual cyclists and families, this paved path follows the canal between the Bourne and Sagamore Bridges. It runs for 7-8 miles and includes wonderful views of the shoreline.

Cape Cod National Seashore Bike Trails: Three bike trails wind through the National Seashore. The 1.6 mile Nauset Bike Trail in Eastham is a narrow immediate path to Coast Guard Beach and includes a panoramic view of the Nauset Salt Marsh. The Head of the Meadow Bike Trail in Truro is a calm two-mile ride along berry bushes and trees. A 5.45 mile loop, the Province Lands Bike Trail in Provincetown passes through pine forests, sandy dunes and cranberry

Falmouth's Shining Sea Bikeway: Built on a former railroad right-ofway, this paved path is also great for the casual cyclist. The only bikeway to feature a seaside section, it winds along the coastline for 10 miles crisscrossing the Salt Pond Bird Sanctuary.

Cape Cod Rail Trail: Running 25 miles from Dennis to Wellfleet, the CCRT is particularly beautiful. You won't want to forget your camera on this stunning stretch of bike path through the scenic heart of the Cape with its notable stops along the way.

Museums

Atwood Museum in Chatham is home to the Chatham Historical Society and includes over 4,000 paintings, decorative arts, maritime artifacts, etc. Explore the Museum grounds and outbuildings, including an 18th century herb garden and The Nickerson North Beach Camp. [chathamhistoricalsociety.org]

Cape Cod Museum of Art, Dennis Founded in 1981, the CCMoA preserves the work of the Cape's finest artists and celebrates the distinctive artistic identity of the Cape, the Islands and the region. The Museum is situated in a beautiful setting surrounded by a sculpture garden at the Cape Cod Center for the Arts. [ccmoa.org]

The Heritage Museum and Gardens in Sandwich has 100 acres of grand grounds and trails and a collection of over 18,000 items celebrating the culture of the people in southeastern New England. The gardens in fall abound the with dahlias, asters, sedum and Japanese anemone. [heritagemuseumsandgardens.org]

The Cape Cod Museum of Natural History in Brewster offers collectionsbased exhibits, including whales and birds, live marine science exhibits and educational and environmental education programs for adults and children. The grounds have three nature trails and a wildflower garden. [ccmnh.org]

Seasbore Strolls

There are six pristine sandy beaches at the Cape Cod National Seashore. Local favorites include the broad sandy Nauset Light Beach in Orleans, the breathtaking Coast Guard Beach in Eastham, and the historic Marconi Beach in Wellfleet. For a unique experience, visit the Brewster Flats, comprised 12,000 acres of tidal flats extending nine miles from Brewster to North Eastham, the largest flats in North America.

Complimentary Launch to the Outer Beach

A complimentary trip to the Outer Beach, part of the famed Cape Cod National Seashore, is not to be missed. The pristine beach features spectacular views of the open Atlantic on one side and serene Pleasant Bay on the other. Our launch service departs from our dock daily beginning at 10am, with last departure at 5pm. After September 10th the launch departs starting 11am. Our club-like bar with a fireplace, serves an à la carte dinner daily, 3pm - 10pm, and cocktails till midnight. Dining is first-come first-serve.




